Competition Volunteer Shifts

The 2025 Sectionals Championships (Oct 31-Nov 3) is your ONLY opportunity to fulfil Competition Volunteer Shift requirements.

The Sign Up Genius link for shifts will be provided to members as the competition schedule/shifts are finalized (likely about October 11-15).

All members will receive an email reminding them to sign up.

Shifts are filled on a first come, first served basis.

As per the 2024/25 Competition Shift requirement, each DSC family must commit to the following Competition Volunteer Shifts:

- IFSA Skater Families no shift
- Private Skater Families 2 shifts required
- All eligible skaters 1 ice patching shift (skaters eligible to PA, Junior level and higher, 9+ years of age)

For the 2024-2025 Season, all figure skating registrations had a \$200 Competition Volunteering Deposit added to their initial invoice. Following the competition, all competition shifts will be reconciled. Families who have completed their requirements will have their deposits credited back to their member accounts.
