



Spring (April/May) 2026 INTRODUCTORY FIGURE SKATING ACADEMY SCHEDULE

This class is designed for skaters between the ages of 4 and 8 (boys aged 9) that show a natural affinity for figure skating. With a curriculum aimed at developing solid fundamentals in a fun, progressive and sequential manner, skaters are prepared for entrance into Skate Canada’s STARSkate or Competitive Skate Programs. Our coaches introduce figure skating specific skills to include edges and turns, beginning jumps and spins, performance and off ice training.

In June, there are two options to choose from, Monday/Wednesdays or Tuesday/Thursdays. Skaters **may** choose to skate twice per week or register for both programs to be on the ice 4 days per week. In IFSA, it is recommended that your skater choose a minimum of 1-camp in June and/or 1-camp in July. Being off the ice from May until August is not advised.

****Skater must be 8 years old or younger (boys, 9) as of July 1, 2025.**

45-minute small group lesson time on ice; 30 min off ice per day
